

How to make the Angelspit Face Mask. You will need:

- 2 X 30cm Eleastic chord
- A piece of black cotton material 21cm * 15cm (8.3"*5.8")
- White spray paint or a thick felt pen
- Needle and thread or sewing maching
- 1) Print out the design (on Page 1) on 110gsm paper
- 2) Cut out the BLACK design with a scalpel

3) Lay the design over a flat piece of cotton material 21cm * 15cm (8.3"*5.8")

4) Spray a thick coat of paint over the design (you can also use thick felt pen). Remove the original paper and leave to dry for 24 hours.


5) Once the paint is dry, place the design face down. Fold the top and bottom along the blue dotted lines (Fig1).

Sew these close to the red dashed lines to make top and bottom hems. Make sure the hems are on the back of the cloth (**Fig2**).

6) Fold the left and right along the blue dotted lines (**Fig3**).

Sew these close to the blue dashed lines to make the side hems (Fig4).

Make sure you leave space on the top and bottom of these side hems for the elastic (**Fig5**).



7) Thread a piece of elastic (roughly 30cm long) through each side hem **(Fig6)**.

8) Tie the elastic at the back to suit your size. Flip the elastic loops behind your ears - this will keep the mask inplace on your face.
